<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Full Day Camp</u> * 8:30 – 5:00 * <u>Drop off begins at 8:15</u> <u>Ask about early drop offs for a small fee!</u></p> <p>Price: \$215 Ages: 3 – 10. Bring Daily: At least 2 drinks, 2 snacks, and a lunch. Full Day Campers will make a SOLA Camp Shirt on Mondays!</p> <p>Pizza Fridays: Only drink and snack need be provided as Pizza is “On SOLA”</p> <p>Wet Fridays: Wear a bathing suit under your clothes and pack a towel, and water shoes!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Afternoon Camp</u> <u>1:00 – 5:00 *</u></p> <p>Price: \$100 Ages: 3 - 10 yrs Bring Daily: Drinks & snacks. Activities: Campers participate in group time, arts and crafts centers, free indoor and outdoor play, and afternoon snack.</p> <p>Set up: Afternoon camps have a <i>maximum</i> camper to counselor ratio of 8-to-1 with approx. 35 kids.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Morning Camp</u> * 8:30 – 12:30 <u>Drop off begins at 8:15</u> <u>Ask about early drop offs for a small fee!</u></p> <p>Price: \$125 Ages: 3 yrs – 10 yrs Bring Daily: Drinks, snacks & lunch (label all containers and lunch box!) Activities: Group time, arts & crafts centers, snack time and free indoor and outdoor play. Lunch is at noon for morning & full day campers only. Half-day morning campers are dismissed at 12:30.</p> <p>Pizza Fridays: Only drink and snack need be provided as Pizza is “On SOLA”</p> <p>Set up: Morning camps have a <i>maximum</i> camper to counselor ratio of 8-to-1 with approx. 35 kids.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>What to Bring & What to Wear! The Rules...</u></p> <p>We have 3 rules: Be gentle, Be respectful and Be safe!</p> <p>Wear messy art clothes. Bring a change of clothes & label everything you bring to camp! Wear Sunscreen (please apply before camp), sun hat & sunglasses. We have additional as needed.</p> <p>Fridays: Full Day & Morning campers don’t forget lunch is provided. Only Full Day Campers will have water play.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Please leave all toys at home.</u></p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>The Cost</u></p> <p>Full Day Camp = \$215 per week Full Day Drop in = \$50 per day</p> <p>Half Day Morning Camp=\$125 per week. Half Day Afternoon Camp= \$100 per week. Half Day Drop in = \$30 per day.</p> <p><u>Early drop off & late pick ups = \$15 - \$20 per wk</u></p> <p><u>The Deposit:</u> Minimum of 50% per week, per child. Remaining Balance to be paid first day of camp.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>*Discount Special*</u></p> <p><u>10% off if you attend 7 weeks of full day camps or 8% off for 8 weeks of half day camps.</u> <u>Here’s what to do:</u></p> <p>Pay your Deposit \$500 for full day campers \$300 for ½ day campers. Pay the deposit by June 1st. Sorry No refunds. Bring the remaining balance of tuition on first day of camp. Attend all of your camps! (If you run short of the 7 or 8 weeks, you will be billed the difference between a discounted rate and a regular rate on the actual # of weeks you attended)</p> <p>In other words we’ve heard, “What happens if I pay for the whole summer then miss a week, do I get a refund or credit?” No, sorry! Please make arrangements to supply a qualified substitute camper in your place. We count on full attendance and can’t make any exceptions.</p> <p>However, “What if I have 2 kids and send one half the time and the other for the rest of the time?” Yes, this deal is per family. But again, we are sorry, you may not split the full summer package with a friend.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>The Staff</u></p> <p>SOLA is owned and operated by Steve Adams, quite a child himself. Remember that tuition payments are due by the first of June/July or Aug.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>CIT Program: Counselor In Training</u></p> <p>Children who are 10 and older who show readiness, and responsibility might be considered for our CIT program. CITs pay half price and help younger campers with projects.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Hours of operation</u></p> <p>SOLA is open at 8:30 and closes at 5:00. Earlier drop off (as early as 8:00) and later pick up (up to 5:30) can be arranged, but require a nominal fee.</p>
